'Mindfulness' has become a buzzword in all areas of life but what about 'Christfulness'? St Patrick describes it well in the prayer also termed his 'breastplate':

Christ be with me,
Christ within me
Christ behind me,
Christ before me
Christ beside me,
Christ beneath
me,
Christ above me



Christfulness has its origins in the experience that God is with us, and comes to life in and through Christ. Just as the word of God became flesh in Jesus Christ, so are we in Christ, given access to the nature of God. Christfulness is an expression of faith, a



spiritual experience and an attitude to life.

The retreat is an invitation to a process which will carry us from an individual and personal experience of the Christ within, to a greater vision of human redemption and the healing of our planet. There will be constant interplay



between the individual and the relational, the personal and the universal.

The retreat will also include body

prayer covering a number of meditative practices such as breathing, walking meditation, body postures, movement which help us open up to the peace and Spirit of God. It shows us how the body can help us relax to enter deeper into the landscape of prayer.

The retreat alternates between corporate prayer, individual silence for reflection, talks and body prayer. Wednesday from morning prayer until Thursday before dinner will be in silence. The beauty of the grounds and accommodation coupled with the use of facilities like the labyrinth, pool and art-room will support participants in their retreat. You will have the offer of one to one sessions of accompaniment / spiritual conversations.
